



## **1-Day Workshop on Participatory & Collaborative Learning (Teachers)**

**Type of event:** Practical in-person training with preparatory digital input and post-workshop peer support

**Target group:** Teachers

### **Short description of the training:**

This workshop introduces teachers to participatory and collaborative learning approaches that actively engage students, encourage peer-to-peer interaction, and support deeper understanding through co-created knowledge. By combining short pre-workshop materials, interactive sharing during the session, and structured follow-up, participants leave with practical strategies they can implement immediately. The programme focuses on exchanging tested methods, addressing classroom complexity, and building a support network for continued experimentation.

### **Framework (structure)**

#### **Before the workshop**

- **Micro-module video:** "What is participatory learning?" – with 2 practical classroom examples.
- **Poll:** Which group formats do you use most and least in your teaching?

#### **During the workshop**

1. **Padlet activity:** Participants contribute their favourite collaborative teaching methods for others to explore.

#### **After the workshop**

- **Mini project support group on Zoom:** Small peer groups test a new participatory activity in their classes and share results.
- **Resource roundup email:** Includes slides, useful links, and a shared folder with strategies for addressing the complexity of classroom teaching.
